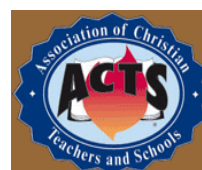

MISSION STATEMENT

Statement of Responsibilities for the Student

CAMPUS LIFE

Students of Calvary Chapel Christian School (CCCS) share in the unique benefits of a Christian campus. In addition to a Christ-centered, spiritual and academic environment that seeks the best education and the richest fulfillment of potential for each individual, students are exposed to an integrated view of learning, which utilizes Scripture as the foundation for all of life. One of the unique purposes of CCCS is to prepare Christian young people for effective service for Christ in whatever career they choose.

CCCS encourages the development of the individual through emphasizing the stewardship of God-given gifts and abilities. The support of peers who share a belief in Jesus Christ is one of the advantages of attending CCCS. The faculty, staff and administrator are available for students who need their support. The extra-curricular activities and programs offered by the school are provided as a stimulus for further growth and development. All that is done in the classroom, in extra-curricular programs, in relationships established and in knowledge gained, should reflect the mission of CCCS.

ASSUMPTIONS

1. That all students of CCCS profess a personal faith in Jesus Christ, and seek His Lordship in their lives.
2. That all students view the Bible to be the authoritative Word of God, and therefore, are subject to its teachings and admonitions. As the Bible establishes the basic principles that guide and develop Christian character and behavior, its standards are paramount to the daily decisions made by individuals within the school.
3. That all students desire to grow and be more like Christ both in word and deed: that their personal commitment to Jesus Christ might mature and deepen while being a part of this school.
4. That all students demonstrate stewardship of their minds, time, abilities, funds and opportunities for intellectual and spiritual growth, as well as care for their bodies as the temples of the Holy Spirit.

GENERAL PRINCIPLES

There are several underlying principles, which need to be exhibited in the behavior and character of a student. By virtue of enrollment a student accepts the rights and responsibilities of attending CCCS. The CCCS student will:

1. Acknowledge that maturity entails both the experience of freedom and the acceptance of limits.
2. Demonstrate the positive attributes of new life in Christ (Rom. 12:6-21; Gal. 5:22-23; Col. 3:12-17; 2 Peter 1:5-9).
3. Support the rights and needs of the school, as well as adhering to all school and classroom rules, regulations and Standards of Conduct on and off campus, 365 days a year.
4. Assume responsibility for his/her own actions, speaking the truth and demonstrating an understanding of his/her individual role before God and to the school.
5. Exhibit a respectful spirit to other members of the school; both students and faculty.
6. Read the Parent/Student Handbook with his/her parents and agree with the rules and regulations therein.

BIBLICALLY SPEAKING

The following behavioral expectations bind all members of CCCS:

1. Those acts expressly forbidden in Scripture, including premarital sexual activity, homosexuality, drunkenness, theft, profanity, occult practices and dishonesty are not to be practiced by members of this school.
2. Those concerns which are often known as "sins of the spirit" and "sins of the tongue" include such sins as covetousness, pride, lust, envy, immodesty, impatience, backbiting, enmity, strife, outbursts of anger, factions, bitterness, an unforgiving spirit, slander, discrimination and prejudice (Jer. 9:3-9; Mark 7:20-23; Gal. 5:19-21). While more difficult to discern, these are equally destructive, and therefore must be overcome.
3. Recognizing the Christian obligation to submit to the governing authorities (Rom. 13:1; 1 Pet. 2:12), students are expected to uphold the rules of the school, laws of the state and the nation.
4. While students may struggle with one or more of the listed sins, each student will seek regular fellowship, counsel, and guidance from pastors, teachers, or other appropriate spiritual leaders – toward full victory and spiritual maturity.

CCCS AGREEMENTS

CCCS states certain guidelines for the conduct of faculty, staff and students. Students of CCCS are expected to refrain from the use of alcoholic beverages, tobacco, illegal drugs or abuse of either prescription or non-prescription drugs and from gambling. In addition, modesty and good taste should guide choices in dress and appearance both on campus and at school-related functions. Strict adherence to the CCCS Dress Code must be maintained. Any association or affiliation with a group or gang, which are contrary to Biblical standards, shall be strictly forbidden. CCCS does not allow social dancing at school-held or sponsored activities (any activity that involves an identifiable school group, is publicized on campus, and/or has the appearance of being school-related, whether held on or off campus). Further, students are expected to use discernment to abstain from activities that are immoral and/or morally degrading. The possession of a weapon(s) on campus or at any school-sponsored event is strictly prohibited. Male and female students are not permitted to exhibit public displays of affection toward one another. Students shall refrain from swearing and the use of any language unbecoming to a Christian, as well as acts of dishonesty such as cheating, lying or stealing. Attending CCCS is a privilege granted to those who demonstrate a spirit of harmony with the philosophy and goals of the school on and off campus, 365 days a year. CCCS reserves the right to dismiss a student who does not conform either to the stated regulations governing student conduct or to the expressed principles, policies, and expectations of the school.

Uniform Dress Standard (High School)

*"... to present your bodies a living and holy sacrifice, acceptable to God,
which is your spiritual service of worship."*

Romans 12:1

As Christians, it is our desire for students to please the Lord and be a good witness to others both in appearance and behavior. We believe there is a definite relationship between proper dress habits, work habits, proper school behavior. We require students to dress modestly and attractively without drawing undue attention to themselves. Students should avoid extreme or questionable fads and fashions. Proper student dress in association with continual effort for good attitude and behavior are important elements of our wholesome Christian learning environment.

The dress standard for boys and girls applies to all student activities (i.e. sporting events, school plays, graduation, etc.) both on and off campus. Administration reserves the right to determine that which attracts undue or excessive attention to the wearer and that which is questionable and inappropriate and is considered unacceptable.

Calvary Chapel Christian School (CCCS) has adopted school uniforms for all students and is to be worn during school hours. All uniforms must be purchased through the School Administration Office; no substitutions are permissible. The following is a list of approved uniforms:

- For P.E., a uniformed T-shirt and gym shorts must be used.
- Uniform clothing for all students must be in good condition, clean and pressed. All clothing must be of appropriate size and should not be too tight or too baggy.
- Uniform clothing for all students must be in good condition, clean and pressed. All clothing must be of appropriate size and should not be too tight or too baggy.
- Students are to wear their hairstyles in a clean, neat and attractive manner avoiding any extreme or questionable hairstyles. Clothing, jewelry or accessories related to a group or gang will not be permitted on campus or at any school activity. Body piercing, tongue rings, nose rings, etc. are not acceptable. Tattoos that can be seen are not acceptable.
- Students are not permitted to wear any hats or beanies indoors or outdoors. This also includes any Christian monogrammed hats or beanies. No sunglasses are allowed in class or at any school function, on or off campus.
- Shoes and socks are to be worn by all students. Spike heels, thongs, sandals, etc. other than the specified uniform footwear are not permitted.
- Collar flaps are to be worn properly on the outside of the polo shirt and not folded inside the neckline. When lifting both arms in the air, there should be no midrib exposure. Polo shirts are to be tucked into the shorts, pants, or skorts and not worn on the outside. Pulling up sleeves that will expose any part of the underarms is unacceptable. No polo shirt or T-shirt is allowed to be pulled back and tied into a knot.
- Girls are permitted to wear jewelry in moderation. They are not permitted to wear makeup or earrings that extend below the earlobe (i.e. hoops). They are permitted to wear clear or natural colored nail polish only. All appropriate undergarments are expected to be worn as part of the girl's attire and should not be visible on her outer body. Girls' skorts should fall no more than ½" above the knee caps when lifting both arms. At least one button on the polo shirt must be worn closed.
- Boys are not permitted to wear any types of earrings, wallet chains, and/or stud necklaces.
- All students clothing and lifestyle should represent a good witness to the world as well as fellow believers and that will glorify the Lord Jesus Christ.
- Violations of any part of the above uniform dress code will result in a student being written up as a uniform dress standard violation.
