How Can I Get Involved?

The Calvary Chapel of Honolulu Servant Requirements form is on Page two of this questionnaire. The Servant Requirements form lists the appropriate steps that are important to serve in a particular ministry. To get a better understanding of the different ministries and where your gifts and talents can be properly utilized, please pick up a ministry overview pamphlet at the Information Desk in the Chapel lobby.

Please review the Servant's Requirements form so that you have an understanding of what level requirements you need to complete.

Steps to getting involved at Calvary Chapel of Honolulu:

1. Contact the staff overseer to verify if there is a current need for volunteers and what specific requirements are needed to serve in ministry.
2. Review the Servant Requirements and the Ministry Opportunities, determine what level of requirement is required for the particular ministry in which you desire to serve.
3. Review the Statement of Faith of Calvary Chapel located on Page 3. If there is anything that is not clear to you before you proceed to fill out the questionnaire, please make an appointment to speak to the Administrator for clarification. ***Can two walk together, unless they are agreed? (Amos 3:3)*** If you understand and agree with the Statement of Faith and have completed the prerequisites, please continue by filling out the questionnaire.
4. Complete this form.
5. Lastly, return the completed questionnaire in an envelope to the Reception Desk "Attention Administrator."

If you are filling out this form to serve in Children's Ministry, Youth Ministry or any other ministry that involves minors, you will be asked to sign a release form for a criminal background check. This form will be given by the Administrator.

SERVANT REQUIREMENTS

Please complete the following requirements and this Ministry Questionnaire.

Servant Requirements – **Level I** (minimum)

- Must be saved and water baptized
- Must have attended Calvary Chapel of Honolulu weekly for at least six months
- Must have completed a Ministry Questionnaire with an **attached photo**
- Must have met with the Staff Overseer

Continued Servant Requirements for Usher, New Believer Counselor, Prayer Team, Sunday School, Off-site Activities, etc. – **Level II**

- Must have met the above criteria in Level 1
- Must have attended “Disciples in Training” Class
- Must have watched the “Venture In Faith” video
- Must have read “Calvary Chapel Distinctives” by Pastor Chuck Smith ***
- Must have read “Charisma vs. Charismania by Pastor Chuck Smith ***

STATEMENT OF FAITH

- Calvary Chapel has been formed as a fellowship of believers in the Lordship of Jesus Christ. Our supreme desire is to know Christ and be conformed to His image by the power of the Holy Spirit. We are not a denominational church, nor are we opposed to denominations as such, only to their over-emphasis of the doctrinal differences that have led to the division of the Body of Christ.
- We believe the only true basis of Christian fellowship is Christ's Agape love, which is greater than any differences we possess and without which we have no right to claim ourselves Christians.
- We believe worship of God should be spiritual. Therefore, we remain flexible and yielded to the leading of the Holy Spirit to direct our worship.
- We believe worship of God should be inspirational. Therefore, we give great place to music in our worship.
- We believe worship of God should be intelligent. Therefore, our services are designed with great emphasis upon the teaching of the Word of God that He might instruct us how He should be worshipped.
- We believe worship of God should be fruitful. Therefore, we look for His love in our lives as the supreme manifestation that we have truly been worshipping Him.
- We believe in all the basic doctrines of historic Christianity.
- We believe in the inerrancy of Scripture, that the Bible, Old and New Testaments are the inspired, infallible Word of God.
- We believe that God is eternally existent in three distinct persons: Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
- We believe that God is the personal, transcendent, and sovereign Creator of all things.
- We believe that Jesus Christ is fully God and fully human, that He was born of a virgin, lived a sinless life, provided for the atonement of our sins by His substitutionary death on the cross, was bodily raised from the dead by the power of the Holy Spirit, ascended back to the right hand of the Father, and ever lives to make intercession for us.
- After Jesus ascended to Heaven, He poured out His Holy Spirit on the believers in Jerusalem, enabling them to fulfill His command to preach the Gospel to the entire world, an obligation shared by all believers today.
- We believe that all people are, by nature, separated from God and responsible for their own sin, but that salvation, redemption, and forgiveness are freely offered to all by the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ. When a person repents of sin and accepts Jesus Christ as personal Savior and Lord, trusting Him to save, that person is immediately born again and sealed by the Holy Spirit, all his/her sins are forgiven, and that person becomes a child of God, destined to spend eternity with the Lord.
- We believe in the gifts of the Holy Spirit mentioned in the Scriptures, and that they are valid for today if they are exercised within the scriptural guidelines. We as believers are to covet the best gifts, seeking to exercise them in love that the whole Body of Christ might be edified. We believe that love is more important than the most spectacular gifts, and without this love all exercise of spiritual gifts is worthless.
- We believe that the church government should be simplistic rather than a complex bureaucracy, and that we depend on the Holy Spirit to lead, rather than on fleshly promotion.
- We await the pre-tribulation rapture of the church, and we believe that the Second Coming of Christ with His saints to rule the earth will be personal, pre-millennial, and visible. This motivates us to holy living, heartfelt worship, committed service, diligent study of God's Word, regular fellowship, participation in adult baptism by immersion and Holy Communion.
- We seek to teach the Word of God in such a way that its message can be applied to the individual's life, leading that person to a greater maturity in Christ.
- We do not embrace: (1) The belief that true Christians can be demon possessed, (2) "5-point Calvinism" (i.e., a fatalistic Calvinistic view that leaves no room for free will; specifically, we reject the belief that Christ's atonement was limited; instead, we believe that He died for all people, and we reject the assertion that God's wooing grace cannot be resisted or that He has elected some people to go to hell; instead, we believe that anyone who wills to come to Christ may do so), (3) "positive confession" (the faith movement belief that God can be commanded to heal or work miracles according to man's will), (4) human prophecy that supercedes the Scriptures, (5) incorporation of humanistic and secular psychology and philosophy into Biblical teaching, and (6) the over-emphasis of the spiritual gifts, experiential signs and wonders to the exclusion of Biblical teaching.
- In our services, we focus on a personal relationship with God through worship, prayer and the teaching of the Word of God. We teach both expositively and topically. We do not allow speaking in tongues loudly during services, nor prophecy while a Bible study is in progress because we do not believe that the Holy Spirit would interrupt Himself. We have specific "after-glow services".

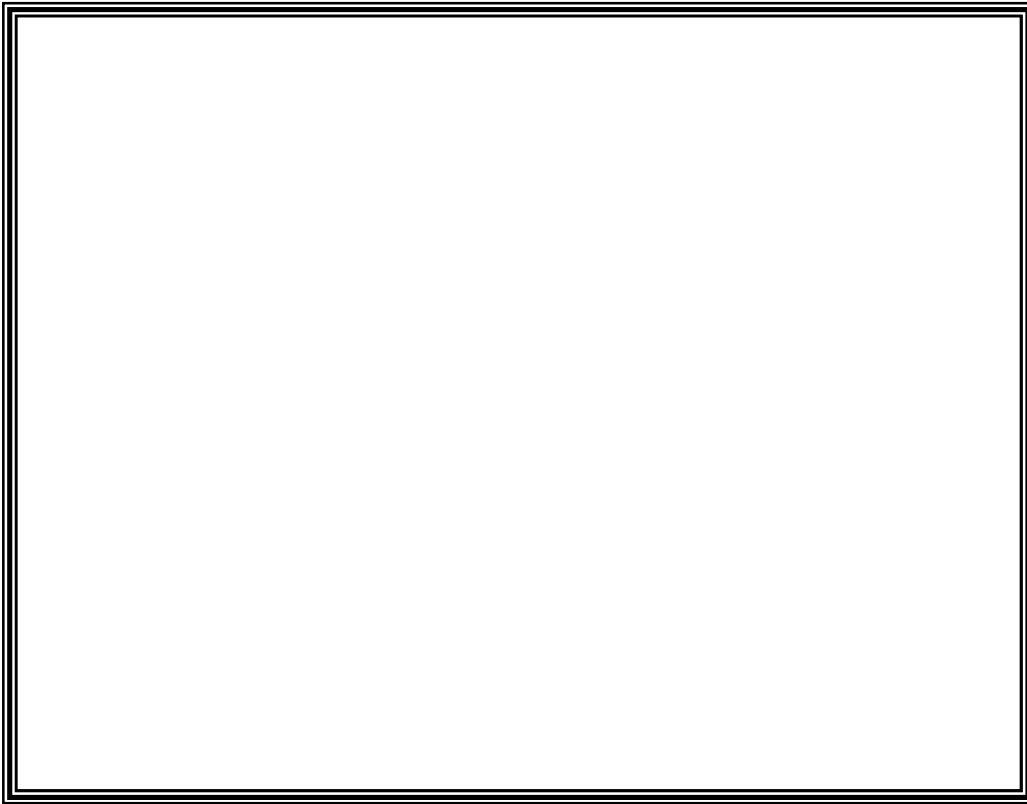
